### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE:**

Greetings in Christ,

Advent is coming! Celebrating Advent involves spending time in spiritual preparation for the coming of Jesus Christ at Christmas. In Western Christianity, the season of Advent begins on the fourth Sunday prior to Christmas Day, or the Sunday which falls closest to November 30, and lasts through Christmas Eve, December 24. Today, more and more Protestant and Evangelical Christians are recognizing the spiritual significance of Advent, and have begun to revive the spirit of the season through serious reflection, joyful expectation, and even through the observance of some of the traditional Advent customs. So, it is time to prepare ourselves spiritually for His coming.

As usual, we are going to have four weeks of Advent Bible Study, on consecutive Wednesdays beginning November 28<sup>th</sup>. This year I would like to offer the class at two different times each Wednesday, one at 10:00 a. m. and one at 7:00 p.m. We are still choosing a book to study, please write your name under the book you prefer, on the message board in the Narthex. The Charge Conference, the annual celebration of our ministry, is coming on December 9<sup>th</sup>. Please, would each committee chairperson submit your report to church office.

I had wonderful time with my families in Korea. I had a big party for my father's birthday and invited 52 family members. I had a chance to meet cousins I never met before. Since I left the Korea in 1984, I have been living separately from my family. I came alone but now I have four of my own family members here in the USA. Traditionally, Koreans thought that blood relationships were natural and ideal starting points for good relationships outside the family, they never assumed that happy family life emerged spontaneously. Harmony and smooth flow of affection were seen as the result of proper patriarchal regulation of women and children. The family should be run as a "benevolent monarchy," the eldest male as household head. Sons remained home after they married, while daughters went to live with their husband's family. But now everything has been changed. Even though I am an eldest son in my family, I now live in the US. So I feel guilty because I am not living with and taking care of my parents. But now I have my extended family at SMUMC, and I thank all of you for being my family.

Well, life is good, I'm happy with my church and God is always with us. Thank you God!




