PASTOR'S MESSAGE:

Greetings in Christ,

Interpersonal conflict is a fact of life and can arise in almost any sphere, from organizations through to personal relationships. Learning to resolve it effectively, in a way that does not increase our stress levels, is therefore important for everyone. As we prepare for the Special Session of the UMC's General Conference, February 23-26, in St. Louis, Missouri, UM News Service has been publishing an abundance of news, feature articles and commentaries to offer information and interpretation about this potentially momentous, challenging, global gathering. The United Methodist Church is not the first Christian body to deal with the potentially church-splintering debate over homosexuality and biblical interpretation. As United Methodists prepare for the special General Conference on February 23rd, they might learn from the experiences of their ecumenical partners, U.S. Episcopalians, Lutherans and Presbyterians. All have dealt with their own divides over the roles of LGBTQ Christians. Since The United Methodist Church formed in 1968, it has only held a General Conference once outside of the normal four-year schedule. That was in 1970, and its purpose was to organize the merger of the Methodist and Evangelical United Brethren denominations. A special session was considered to address the worldwide economic crisis of 2008. The bishops in 2009 ultimately opted not to call that session. I don't know what their final decision this year is going to be. But we all can know their final decision after February 26th. Let us pray for that important conference.

No matter what happens, we need to be united. In Ephesians 4:4-6 we read, "There is one body, and one Spirit, even as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all, and in you all." Just as there is only one God, there is only one body. What is this one body? In Ephesians 1:21-22 we find out what this one body is, "And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be the head over all things to the church, which is His body." Here we see that the Bible says the church is the body. So the one body is the one church which belongs to the Lord. We are one body and our Lord, Jesus Christ is our head.

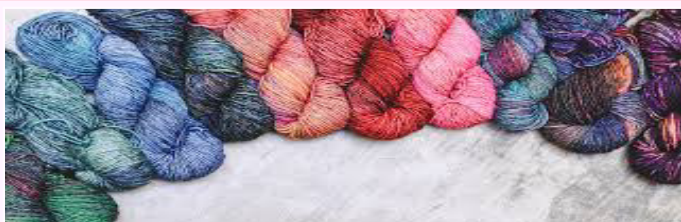

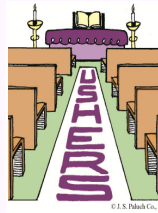

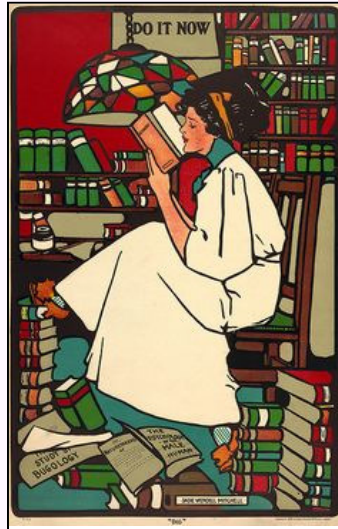
