PASTOR'S MESSAGE:

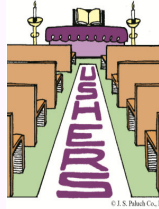

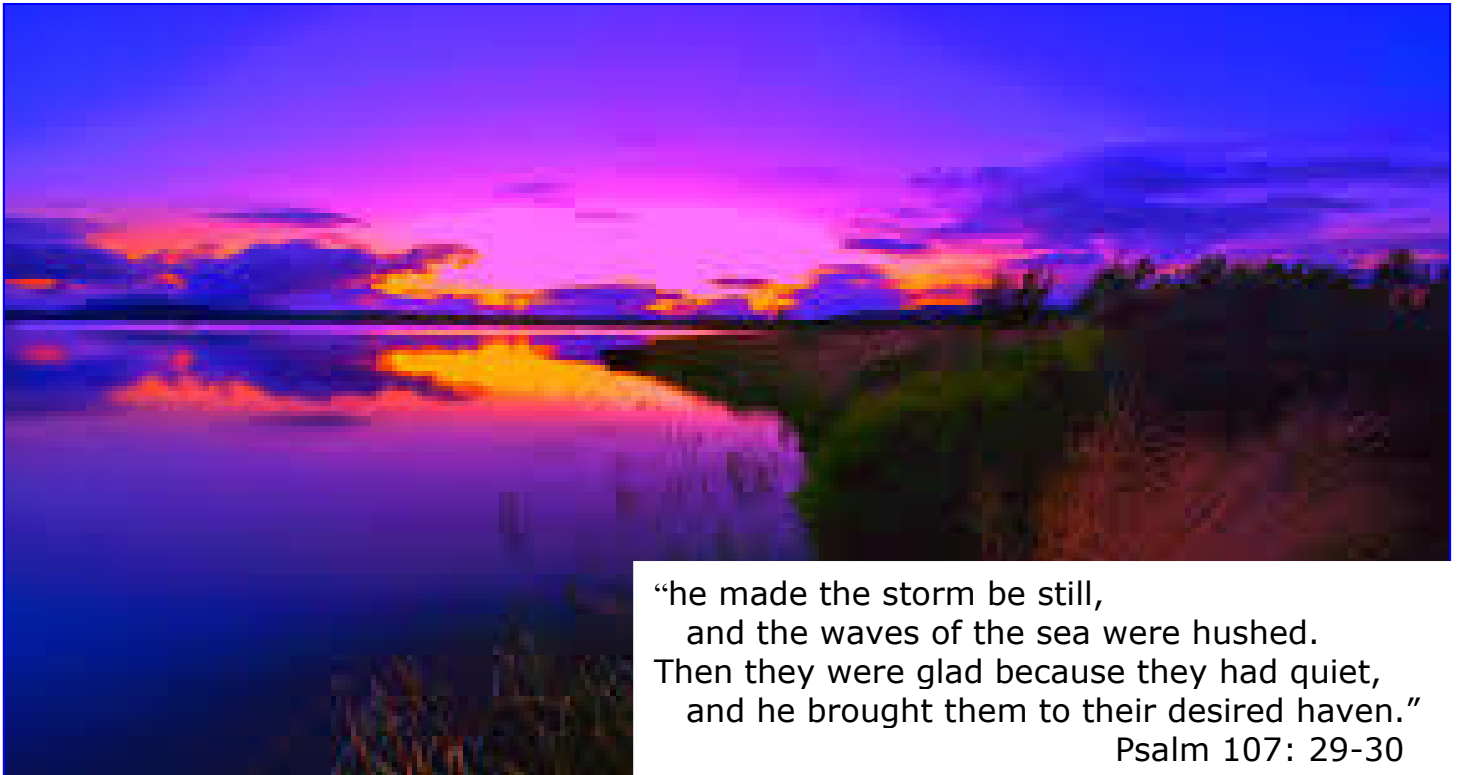

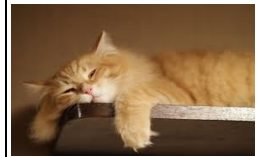
