

# A Message from PASTOR JAE "Again, the Hidden Treasures"

#### 70th Birthday of Sierra Madre Ministry is coming in December!



Springtime is a good time to dream of dreams in imagination. It is because the Spring is the season of revealing what's underneath the soil. If the seeds are planted, they will sprout, grow and bloom in God's time. God excavates what's hidden underneath. I am thankful that Spring is finally around the corner after the long rainy season.

When I first began the study of theology in my late twenties, resigning from a business company for the call from God, one of the classes which excited me the most was the Old Testament studies. I was fascinated in wonder not only with the steadfastness and sincerity of God throughout the history with each book of the Old Testament, but also with its archaeology. One of the Old Testament professors amazed me greatly with his knowledge of the land of the Bible and its archaeology.

The Biblical archaeology is defined as the study of the archaeological remains of the peoples, cultures, and periods in which the biblical texts were formed. 


