A Message from **PASTOR JAE**

"With Easter, the New Engine Is Installed!"



As I prepared myself for the final todays of suffering of Jesus in the passion week, and as I prepared for Easter Children's message, I stopped by a Japanese supply store, Daiso (*read aloud Dai-So?*). There, I found a very interesting thing. *It was a pinwheel, a little spinner.*

Immediately, I bought six of them. The next day, I asked my wife Yang, "Would you go buy more?" So, she bought twenty of them. Then, Friday morning, I went there again to buy more of them. But no more was there. It was all sold out. Guess who purchased them all? So, I had to go to another Daiso. There, I bought fifteen of them. All together, how many? Forty-one pinwheels!

There was a reason. When I placed them here and there on our church campus, I felt like I was going back to my younger days and became a little boy again! It was a great feeling that I became a child again with the pinwheels. I do not know what exact magic the pinwheels did to me. But when I looked at the pinwheels spinning in the wind breezes, I became one of them, feeling my heart and mind spinning like them. *It is like a childlike engine being re-generated in my heart!*

We all know how pinwheels spin. They take winds, as it gives itself up to the wind breezes, coming around and coming through them. Then they spin! No resistance, but they spin, as they surrender themselves to the wind, which is the same word, the Holy Spirit in our Christian term. As we give ourselves up to God in his Spiritual breezes, God spins us and we are re-generated! Isn't it awesome? In my younger days, all the boys in my village knew how to make their own pinwheels. No winds...? We didn't care. Instead of waiting for the wind breezes, we ran all together, holding the pinwheels up in the air as high

as we could. The little boys never gave up! We all remember what Jesus said at Matthew 18:3, "Unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven."

According to the Gospel of John 20, Easter has come with Mary's notification. When Mary got there, *the tomb was empty*, which means that the tortured and pierced body of Jesus wasn't there. Instead, the two angels guarded that empty tomb. Then, as she



turned around, Mary saw a man and she thought he was the gardener of the cemetery. Still crying in tears and sorrow, Mary asked. "My Lord was taken away from here. Tell me where you put him." Strangely enough, now, that man seemed to know her name and called her, "*Mary*!"

What a voice it was, that she wanted to hear again! What a tender voice it was, which she had missed! We all do have some voices that we want to hear again, missing them. Now, Mary knows whose voice it is. It is Jesus. Unbelievable, but it was real! Jesus is risen, as he already told them. Then, the risen Jesus asks her, saying, "Go to my brothers and sisters and tell them. *I am risen. The tomb cannot swallow me up and cannot keep me in darkness.* My Father God got me out of there and I arose from that tomb of darkness! Tell them, soon, I will get to Galilee and meet them there. No one can stop our dreams! Our Father God won't let that happen! Nothing can disconnect us from the promise of our Father God! *Our Father God is real!* God turned the tomb into a birthplace of that dream and the promise!" I paraphrased what Jesus said.

How would you take this Easter news that the young woman Mary brings to you? Would you still like to search for the body of Jesus in that empty tomb? Or would you convince yourself with that Easter news and run to Galilee, to the place that the risen Jesus promised to meet you? Or crying in tears, would you continue to stay in front of the tomb? Where would you like to be?

A few pinwheels are placed in front of the parsonage. As they spin, they stop people there. In particular, all children reach out to touch them. Then I walk out to them, and asked, "Would you like to take one? Why not?" Usually, their mom or dad ask them to say, "Thank you."

However, the children continue paying attention to the spinning pinwheels. I am just happy to see them happy, with a hope that the new engine of Easter generates their life in the breezes of God's spirit. We are now in May! Are we all ready to move forward with this new engine of Easter?

- These classes are designed for those who are preparing for confirmation, those who want to re-confirm their basic Christian beliefs, AND those who want to prepare to be members of our Church.




