## History of the Alternative Gift Fair and Boutique

We held our first Alternative Gift Fair (AGF) in 2007, raising around \$3000. The goal was to provide opportunities to give meaningful gifts rather than more "stuff" to friends and family while also helping others in our community and around the world. Such gifts might be a flock of chickens through Heifer, a can of nails for Habitat for Humanity or medical equipment for our missionaries in Mexico. During the early years we sold Fair Trade coffee, and items on consignment from 10 Thousand Villages and SERV and had a chance to meet representatives from each organization.

Then in 2012 June Drenten joined our congregation, bringing along her talents for making crafts and homemade items. Thus, the Boutique was born to supplement the AGF. Each year June and her team work hard to create a wonderful display of handmade items, and others bake cookies and Christmas treats for our Bake Sale. Traditionally all proceeds from the Boutique and Bake Sale go to Family Promise of San Gabriel Valley, a program of which SMUMC was a founder member.

The AGF/Boutique event also offers an opportunity for the congregation to sign Christmas cards for our homebound members. Connie Wortham has produced beautiful home-designed cards for many years.

Our 17<sup>th</sup> Alternative Gift Fair/Boutique/Bake Sale will be held on December 3. 2023 upstairs in Hartzell Hall in conjunction with our 70<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations and will also be available the following week after worship. Please help us with this important Outreach Ministry.
