

A Message from **PASTOR JAE**

"A Sanctuary of Healing"



During the week of my New Year's break, I journeyed to two places, with a plan to get new innovative ideas and inspirations for the church ministry as well as for my life's spiritual journey. It was an opportunity to review and preview. One of the places which caught my attention was a garden gallery in a small enclave of a city I visited. In calm and neat interconnected spaces, plants, sculptures, and paintings were creating a garden of God's heaven. There was an ecological beauty, in which each piece was allowed to enjoy its presence. Even the little ceramic bowl had its own voices, resonating with the others.

I love plants and art. Taking care of plants is an inspiration. Healing and repotting them not only inspires me, but also enriches my soul. It feels like I am conversing with them, even though we don't speak to each other verbally. At one of the corners of the shop in that garden gallery, God seemed to tell me, saying "Jae, what if you and I take this image of a garden and turn our community and church into this kind of place of healing and regeneration?"

Sometimes I get orchids as a gift. Now I've learned how to take care of them. But in the past, the orchids that I received didn't last long. Overwatering or neglect were the main causes. Most of the time, I am aware that something needs to be done for each one of them. Unfortunately, however, action-taking is often too late. For the time being, I've learned that this is not only my experience, but that of many others. We all feel sorry for those who are not doing well or dying. Our lives are not that different from

It is time to act. Bring your dying orchids to church. A spring season is around the corner.
