A Message from **PASTOR JAE**

"Let Us Continue our Journey in the Spirit of Pentecost!"



The weather in Southern California is strangely odd. I hoped for Spring to arrive in April, and it didn't. Easter was early this year, at the end of March. It is natural to expect an earlier Spring with the arrival of Easter. However, it didn't take place. I longed to see Spring in May. Unfortunately, however, it

didn't happen. Rather, the weather has justified the term, "May Gray". How much longer do I need to wait for Spring?

"Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up" (Galatians 6:9).

Growing up in Korea, Winters were cold. Fortunately, around a corner of my house, there was a sun bay facing the southeast. During winter vacation from school, a country boy didn't have much to do at home. There was no TV, no toys or electronic games. In the morning when I stayed inside, my mother would say, "Jae, go out and play." It was too early in the morning to go skating and sledding, which was one of my winter afternoon entertainments.

The only place the little country boys could sit and enjoy was the sun bay corner of my house. My uncles were already outside chopping firewood, but the little boys were not allowed to play around them, only to watch them. As little boys got bored, they came up with something to enjoy it. Who can subdue the adventuresome country boys with a lot of curiosity? They played with the sun, putting their faces up with their eyes closed. It was a sunbath for their faces. After a moment, they felt the sun coming closer down to them with its soothing touches. Even though they knew nothing about vitamin D, through the sunbath, they could all continue to be born again as country boys with suntanned faces in the season of Winter.

and within our children there is a big person with lots of curiosity. That is the reason why they have many questions to ask.

Would you like to nurture the little person within you? If so, then, June is a great month to walk into. With "June Gloom", it may not be warm enough for us to take the adventuresome journey. But let us think about the adventuresome little boys in the winter season. Don't you know we are already in the spirit of Pentecost, which brought the holy fires into our heart? What would you like to do this summer? Let us plan ahead for summer church and its ministry! Friends, let us remember. God is at work around us as well as within us.




"Tremors in the Blood"


