A Message from **PASTOR JAE**

"Aren't You Proud of Your Church?"

Years ago, when my wife Yang went into labor for our first baby, it was about midnight, I was nervous without knowing what to do. During labor, surprisingly enough, Yang gave me specific instructions. "Call a taxi and take me to



the hospital with the bag I prepared." As we arrived at the woman's hospital, I had to awaken the nurse on duty. She didn't look happy.

Pains would ebb and flow, every five minutes, every three minutes, then every two minutes. For the moment of the first baby, I thought I had educated myself well about how I could be prepared. However, all that learning hardly helped a new young dad handle the labor process. The doctor didn't prescribe a pain reliever, but Yang was able to sustain herself through the pain. As her pain attacked every minute, she was moved to a birth room, which I was not allowed to enter. Waiting anxiously outside the room, I was also in labor, waiting for the first cry of the baby. With a few of fragile cries, my first baby was born as morning broke. I was proud of my wife Yang. I was also proud of my first baby.

"We know that the whole creation has been groaning in labor pains until now" (Romans 8:22). Thankfully, that morning, I was able to be born again as a dad, with a realization that giving birth was not possible without pain. I was proud of myself.

General Conference of the United Methodist Church

The 2020 General Conference was set to happen in Minneapolis, Minnesota, until the pandemic made it necessary to postpone the quadrennial legislative event until 2024. The postposed 2020 conference will now be held from April 28 to May 3, 2024, in Charlotte, North Carolina. Meeting every four years, General Conference is the only entity that speaks for the denomination and is the top policy-making body of the UMC. The *United Methodist Book of Discipline*, updated every four years, incorporates changes made by General Conference.

East District Conference

The East District of the California-Pacific Conference will hold its annual meeting by ZOOM on May 11, 2024

California-Pacific Conference

The California-Pacific Conference will hold its annual conference from June 12 to June 15, 2024, in Burbank, California.

Voting members for all these meetings are made up of half clergy and half laity. Pastor Jae and I are SMUMC's voting representatives for the Cal-Pac and East District Conferences.




