



A Message from **PASTOR JAE**

"The Path We Walk Together"







The "wistaria" patio beside the Library Lounge is one of those treasured places. The two benches behind the sanctuary, sheltered by the tall coast redwoods and fig trees, are another. Not long ago, wistaria blossoms spilled over the patio in a lavender fragrance. Now they're gone, leaving behind a canopy of green—and the lingering memory of camp-out night with our children. Around the two benches,

stillness gathers like a soft prayer. A grateful peace settles in, carried by gentle breezes and the many memories of worship shared here over the past three years. It has been a healing. It has been a blessing.

A man of wisdom once said, "There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven" (Ecclesiastes 3:1). Trusting that there is a time to be appointed in and a season to be appointed out, I place myself in God's hands, wondering in faith what lies ahead on my path of calling.

I remember the day I first unpacked the moving boxes. I asked myself: How much energy do I still have? What if my English isn't enough? As I Googled to find the right words for my first sermon, I was nervous and afraid. My lips were dull, and my mind felt slow. But after that first Sunday, it felt as if God had placed me exactly where I needed to be. You welcomed me and my family—not just as newcomers, but as your own. I felt at home. I could be myself.

You prayed with me. You laughed with me. I was able to work beside you. I was blessed as you shared joys and concerns in every season. In your presence, I found healing I didn't know I needed, and strength I



didn't know I had. The rummage sales, the Free Coffee Sanctuary, the costume Sunday, Christmas caroling, the relief stations after the Eaton Fire... and the children's moments—bubbles, balloons and paper planes.

Thank you—for your kindness, your trust, your stories, and your faith. Thank you for letting me walk with you. This is what we did together: "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field" (Matthew 13:44).



As I take my leave, I do so with a full heart. I carry your love with me. I carry your prayers. And I leave mine with you. After the front lawn project was completed, one of my grateful joys has been walking the new cart path—heading toward Michillinda Avenue, then turning beside the wall toward the parking lot. Each time I walk it, I feel as if God is

leading us forward—into the world out there, together with Him. God never stops until the final day of victory.

May the Lord bless you and keep you. May Christ's peace guard your hearts. And may the Spirit lead you forward—with childlike awe, with courage, and with joy.
